Mission

The Acceleration Options Working Group is a local Citizens' Advisory Commission subcommittee created to study potential impacts of accelerating the disposal of chemical weapons stored at the Pueblo Chemical Depot. The group's mission is two fold:

- To advise the Colorado Chemical Demilitarization Citizens' Advisory Commission on matters related to acceleration of the chemical weapons destruction process at the Pueblo Chemical Depot, and
- To serve as a focus and conduit for public discussion of issues related to proposed acceleration options in an effort to develop consensus.
