### CDCAB to meet on Feb. 23

Richmond, Ky. -- The Chemical Destruction Community Advisory Board will meet Monday, Feb. 23 from 1-5 p.m. at Eastern Kentucky University's Carl D. Perkins Building located on Kit Carson Drive.

The board, which is co-chaired by Madison County Judge-Executive Kent Clark and Craig Williams, Director of the Chemical Weapons Working Group, will be finalizing its ground rules and identifying key issues for future discussion. In addition, the board will be identifying additional strategies for continuing involvement of the local community in the chemical destruction decision-making process. The CDCAB will also be receiving project updates from the Program Manager for Assembled Chemical Weapons Alternatives, Bechtel Parsons Blue Grass and the Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection.

As diverse representatives of the local community, board members have been selected to provide advice and citizen input on issues regarding the chemical weapons destruction project at the Blue Grass Army Depot. Board members were selected through a series of community forums and meetings. The board held its first meeting in October 2003.

All board meetings are open to the general public. There will be a public comment period at the conclusion of the meeting.
